### Prizes

You must read for at least **three** hours a week to qualify for prizes. Reading can be done alone or with a parent/sibling/friend, etc. Don't forget that magazines, comic books, audio books and story times count!

In the spirit of "Going Green" **our small weekly toy prizes** will be recycled prizes from years past. Participants who read at least 3 hours a week may come in to choose a prize from our treasure box. These prizes are not appropriate for children under 3.

There are random days where free bowling, mini golf, and museum passes will be

handed out to people who visit the library to log in their hours. These days are random and announced only on our Facebook page. Make sure to "like" us to get updates.

One lucky participant each week will be selected to win a **bigger** prize from our gift shelf located in the display case in the front of the library. These include gift certificates, books, sports tickets, and other donations.
